APPLICATION & RE-ENROLLMENT FEES

- Application Fee (New Families): \$200 per family, due with submission of the Family Application Packet. This nonrefundable fee reserves your student's place in the program pending completion of admission requirements.
- Early-Bird Re-Enrollment Fee (Returning Families): \$100 per family (March 10–18)
- Standard Re-Enrollment Fee (Returning Families): \$200 per family (March 19–April 30)

TUITION, FACILITY FEE & LATE PAYMENT

- Tuition: Tuition per student is due in full by August 1, 2026. Tuition is a nonrefundable, full-year commitment and is not prorated by class or semester. Withdrawal does not relieve a family of tuition or fee obligations.
- Late Payment: A \$35 late fee will be assessed on the first day of each month for any outstanding balance after the due date.
- Participation in Libertas activities may be suspended if tuition or fees remain unpaid.
- An extended payment plan may be available upon request.
- Facility Fee: \$200 per family, due August 1, 2026.

EXPLORATION PROGRAM

K5–3rd Grade (Ages 5–8) — Lower Grammar Stage: Cultivation of Wonder & Virtue

- Monday: \$850 / year
- Tuesday (Half-Day): \$600 / year
- Tuesday (Extended Day): \$850 / year

EXCURSION PROGRAM

4th–6th Grade (Ages 9–11) — Upper Grammar Stage: Cultivation of Language, Literature, & Number Sense

- Monday: \$850 / year
- Tuesday: \$850 / year

EXPEDITION PROGRAM

7th–8th Grade (Ages 12–13) — Dialectic Stage: Cultivation of Logic, Collaboration, & Wisdom

9th–12th Grade (Ages 14–18) — Rhetoric Stage: Cultivation of Rhetoric & Art (Making)

- Monday: \$1,450 / year
- Tuesday: \$1,450 / year

SERVICE CONTRIBUTION FEE

Libertas is a cooperative community that relies on parent volunteers. Each family is assigned a service role to help support community operations. Failure to fulfill an assigned service role may result in a \$50 Service Contribution Fee and, in rare cases, removal from the program.

MISSED ORIENTATION FEE

Program Orientation is held one week before classes begin. Attendance by the student and at least one parent is required. A \$100 Missed Orientation Fee will be assessed for failure to attend.

LATE ADMISSION/RE-ENROLLMENT

All required admission and registration materials, including background checks, must be submitted by April 30, 2026. A one-time \$100 late fee will be assessed if any required materials are submitted on or after May 1, 2026.
